



Weekend Service Changes

Jan 9 – 11 and Jan 16 – 17

Ongoing construction to replace the **A C** mezzanine ramps and staircases will affect subway service and transfers within the Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau station complex. By Monday, January 18th, the ramp near Broadway on the west side of the **A C** mezzanine will be removed and replaced with a temporary staircase.

Other subway work these weekends will impact service in Lower Manhattan, Brooklyn, and certain connections at the Fulton St / Broadway Nassau St complex.

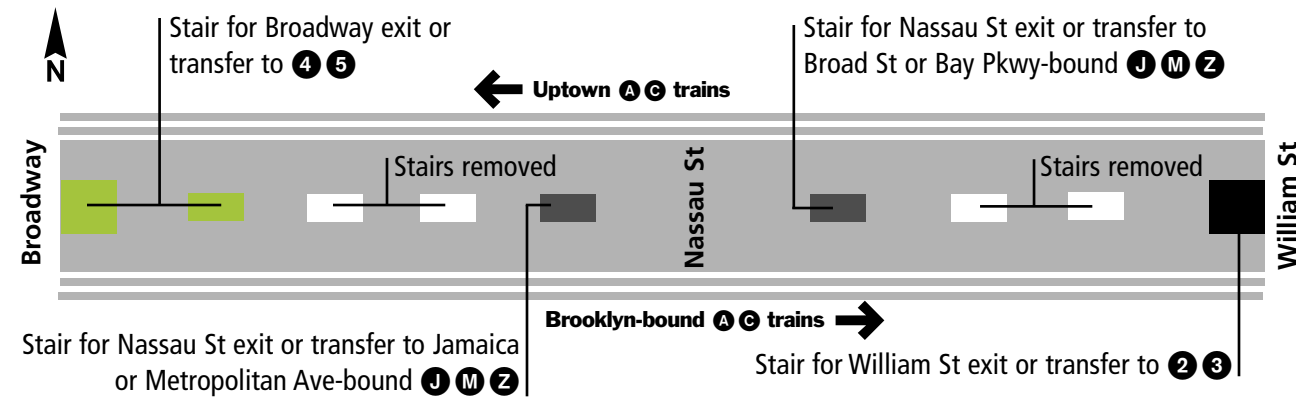
This brochure contains important information on how to travel during these times. MTA New York City Transit will have personnel on site to provide travel directions and wayfinding during these weekends.

Effective Monday, January 18, 2010

- Ramp between **A C** and **4 5**/Broadway replaced by temporary stair
- Some **A C** platform stairs and lower mezzanine closed for reconstruction
- Remaining **A C** platform stairs lead to specific transfers or street exits

Construction Update

Over the next three years, construction work on the Fulton Street Transit Center will continue to affect customers traveling within the station complex. This work is necessary to allow construction of new stairs, elevators and escalators as well as construction of new entrances. As work progresses, barricades will be moved and affect the customer flow through the complex - at times this will result in more crowding.

Customers are strongly advised to look for wayfinding signs and service notices that will provide information about the construction projects' impact on station conditions. This brochure provides a guide to station and service changes that need to take place during two weekends in January 2010.

We apologize for the inconvenience. The new Fulton Street Transit Center will provide many benefits – more station entrances, light and airy station mezzanines, full ADA accessibility, and improved transfer connections between all subway lines. There will be station access to the R, W and E subway lines and access to PATH and the World Trade Center. Lower Manhattan will finally have a prominent major transportation hub that is both beautiful and functional.

Saturday, January 9 (12:01 AM) through Monday, January 11 (ends 5 AM)

At Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St:

- The direct ramp between the A and the 4 5 trains will be closed. Use the alternate path as shown by the wayfinding signs (arrows) in the station.
- To transfer between A trains and Brooklyn-bound 4 5 trains:
 - 4 5 customers must exit the station to connect to A service by re-entering at the station entrance at 222 Broadway (on Fulton St by Chase Bank).
 - A customers must exit the station to connect to Brooklyn-bound 4 5 service by re-entering at

the station entrance on the northwest corner of Broadway and Fulton St (next to St Paul's Chapel).

Other diversions affecting travel:

- There is no 2 or 3 train service into Brooklyn and no 2 or 3 train service at Fulton Street / Broadway-Nassau Street.
- The 2 train will make all 1 train stops from Chambers Street to South Ferry.
- The 3 train will run from 148th Street to 14th Street.
- There is no C train service; use the A train instead. Buses replace trains on A line between Jay Street and Utica Avenue. (Note: only on Sunday,

January 10th, no A trains between Euclid Ave and Lefferts Blvd)

Alternative Travel recommendations:

- The 5 train will be making all regular 2 train stops in Brooklyn to Brooklyn College / Flatbush Avenue. Between 12:01 AM and 6 AM a shuttle train replaces the 5.
- The 4 train will be making all regular 3 train stops in Brooklyn to New Lots Avenue.
- Brooklyn-bound customers wanting the 2 3 trains at Fulton Street/Broadway-Nassau Street must board (or stay on) Brooklyn-bound 4 5 trains.



Saturday, January 16 (12:01 AM) through Monday, January 18 (ends 5 AM)

At Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St:

- There are no 4 5 trains at Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St, take the J shuttle train instead.
- For uptown 4 trains, use the J shuttle train between Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St and Chambers St – Brooklyn Bridge. Uptown 5 service is available at Grand Central/42 Street.
- For connection to the A train:
 - Take the J shuttle train from Chambers St-Brooklyn Bridge to Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St
- For Brooklyn-bound 4 service:
 - Use Brooklyn-bound 2 3 trains at Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St

Or

At Fulton St/Broadway-Nassau St, use a Brooklyn-bound J shuttle train and connect to 2 3 trains at Atlantic Avenue. 2 3 trains in Brooklyn are making 4 5 stops.

Other diversions affecting travel:

- There is no 4 train service between Brooklyn Bridge and Utica Avenue; J shuttle train replaces the 4 service into Brooklyn from Essex Street to Prospect Park.
- There is no 5 train service between Grand Central / 42nd Street and Brooklyn College / Flatbush Avenue.
- The 3 will make regular stops in Brooklyn to New Lots Av and the 2 train will make regular stops in Brooklyn to Brooklyn College / Flatbush Avenue
- There is no C service; take the A instead.

J shuttle trains

- Replaces 4 train service between Brooklyn Bridge/City Hall and Atlantic Avenue
- J shuttle runs between Essex Street and Prospect Park

J shuttle stops are:

- Essex St F
- Bowery
- Canal St N Q R 6
- Chambers St 4 6
- Fulton St A 2 3
- Broad St
- Court St R
- Lawrence St R
- DeKalb Av Q R
- Atlantic Av 2 3 D Q N R (stops at Q platform)
- 7 Av Q
- Prospect Park Q
